Young Players - Code of Conduct

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behavior in the game. As a player, you have a big part to play. That's why we are asking every player to follow this 'Respect Code of Conduct'

When I play sports, I will:

- Have Fun and enjoy it!
- Always play to the best of my ability and maintain a positive attitude.
- Recognize that being on a team means a commitment to my coach and teammates.
- Play fair I will not cheat, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and my coach(es).
- Understand, follow and play by the rules, as directed by the referee.
- Practice good sportsmanship at all times
- Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game.
- Accept that profanity and violence is not acceptable in any situation.
- Listen and respond to what my coach tells me.
- Talk to someone I trust at the MJCCA if I am unhappy about the team, league or program.

- Be required to apologize to my team-mates, the other team, referee or coach.
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or Sports Director.
- Be dropped (left out) or substituted.
- Be suspended from training/practice.
- Be required to leave the program.

Remember children's sports are a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything!

Play your part and please observe the Respect Code of Conduct at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for FUN.
- Applaud effort & good play as well as success. Encourage and support their endeavor.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, coaches & referee.
- Always respect the referees' decisions. Do not berate the referee over calls made/not made.
- Remain outside the field of play and within the designated Parent/Fan areas, bleachers etc
- Let the coaches do their job and not confuse the players by shouting instructions. No coaching!
- Avoid criticizing players for making a mistake – Mistakes are a part of learning.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive behavior or language.

- Issued with a verbal warning from the MJCCA.
- Obliged to leave the fields or campus.
- Required to meet with the Sports Director.
- Required not to attend future matches.
- Suspended and have my membership revoked.
- Required to leave the Center along with any dependants.

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behavior in the game.

The MJCCA is instituting a Respect program to ensure that sports can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. In a recent survey the biggest concern highlighted among participants was behavior – including abuse towards officials and the behavior of over competitive parents & coaches on the touchline.

Play your part and please observe the Respect Code of Conduct at all times.

On and off the field, I will:

- Recognize that children play sports to have fun. Success should be measured in terms of the child's desire to continue playing the sport (not seasonal victories)
- Show respect for others involved in the game; officials, players, coaches, staff & spectators.
- Adhere to the laws and the spirit of the game.
- Always respect the umpire/referees' decisions.
- Promote Fair Play & high standards of behavior.
- Never enter the field of play without permission.
- Never engage in public criticism of umpires/referees.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive behavior or language.

When working with players, I will:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything, including winning.
- Explain exactly what I expect of players and what they can expect from me.
- Ensure al parents understand my expectations.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, bullying in any form.

- Develop mutual trust and respect with every player to build theirs self-esteem.
- Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own behavior, actions and performance.
- Ensure all activities I organize are appropriate for the players' ability, ages and maturity.
- Co-operate fully with all other coaches, referees and officials.

- Required to meet with the Sports Director.
- Monitored by the Director or Commissioner
- Suspended by the Center from attending games.
- Relieved of my position.
- Suspended and have my membership revoked.
- Required to leave the Center along with any dependants.

Match Officials - Code of Condcut

The MJCCA is initiating a Respect program to ensure that sports can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. The behavior of match officials has an impact, directly and indirectly, on the conduct of everyone involved in the game – both on the field and on the sidelines.

Play your part and please observe the Respect Code of Conduct at all times.

I will:

- Be honest & completely impartial at all times.
- Apply the Laws of the Game and competition rules fairly and consistently.
- Manage the game in a positive, calm and confident manner.
- Deal with all instances of violence, aggression, unsporting behavior, foul play and other misconduct.
- Never tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behavior from players and officials.
- Set a positive personal example by promoting good behavior and showing respect for everyone involved in the game.
- Communicate with the players and encourage air Play.
- Respond in a clear, calm and confident manner to any appropriate request for clarification by team captains or coaches.

- Prepare physically & mentally for very game.
- Complete and submit, accurate and concise reports/scores within the time limits required for the games which I officiate.

- Required to meet with the Sports Director.
- Monitored by the Director or Referee Coordinator
- Suspended by the Center from officiating matches.
- Relieved of my position.
