Why should I participate in the Georgia Yellow Dot Program?

Are you 55+ or medically fragile? If yes, Yellow Dot Program is for you! Yellow dot provides information on medical conditions, medications, or medical allergies that will help first responders and medical professional make the best decisions about your emergency medical treatment.

How does it work?

It's as simple as filling out a form and placing a Yellow Dot decal on your vehicle and near the main entrance to your home. This decal will alert first responders that vital medical information is stored in the glove compartment of your vehicle or on the refrigerator in your home.
