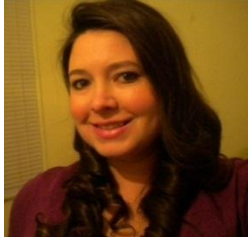
Tara Brooks – Kindergarten Girls

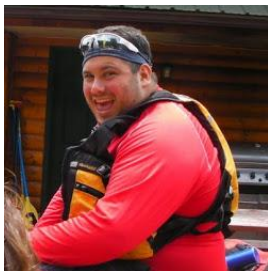
Kim MacKain – First Grade Girls

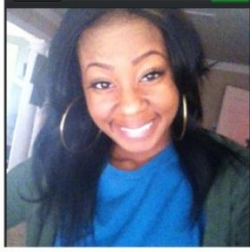
LaToya Crayton – First Grade Girls

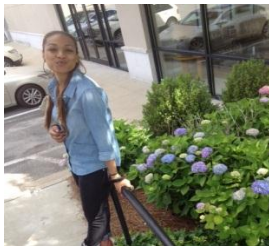
Samantha Goldberg – Second Grade Boys
