#### **About The Harvey Rubin Scholarship Award**

The Harvey Rubin Scholarship Award was founded in 2002 by Philip and Amy Rubin in memory of Philip's father. Currently in its 18th year, this merit-based scholarship award recognizes the outstanding leadership of a high school senior in the Marcus Jewish Community Center of Atlanta and the Atlanta Jewish community. The scholarship award helps a Jewish teen further their education while providing a unique philanthropic opportunity to give-back through a monetary donation to a program at the MJCCA that helped develop their leadership role in the Jewish community.

#### Applicant criteria:

- Must identify yourself as Jewish
- Be a high school senior
- Live in the metro-Atlanta area
- Attend a college or university program or participating in a post-high school continued education program (i.e. gap year) beginning fall 2019
- Active in Atlanta Jewish life (in or outside of the MJCCA)
- Current or past participant in any MJCCA program or activity
